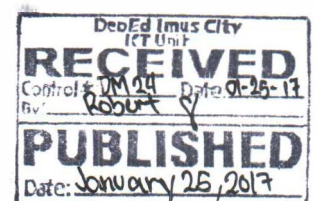
DIVISION ACADEMICS AND CO-CURRICULAR COMPETITIONS FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

TO: Chief-SGOD/OIC-Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
School heads/Officer-In-Charge (Public Elementary, JHS)

1. Pursuant to the Regional Special Competitions and Festival of Talents and in recognition of the Children with Special Needs (CSN) capacity to take active participation in nation building, this office announces the Division Academics and Co-Curricular Competition for Children with Special Needs to be held at Gov.DM Camerino Elementary School on February 8, 2017.
2. This competition aims to:
 - a. come up with the Division participants to the 2017 Regional Academics and Co-Curricular Competitions For Children With Special Needs,
 - b. showcase the potentials of children with special needs to strengthen their confidence and self-esteem,
 - c. provide special children and students opportunities to build friendship, become part of the mainstream and get enjoyment and
 - d. ensure that the physical, social, emotional, intellectual and spiritual personality of CSN are developed.
3. School entries, Psycho-Education Assessment (for intellectually Disabled (ID) –IQ level – 70 & below) for visually impaired (LV & TB – visual acuity) and disability assessment for other disabilities, should be submitted to the Division Office on or before February 7, 2017.
4. Expenses of the participants relative to their participation to this activity are chargeable against SPED and local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
5. Specific Guidelines of the Competitions are contained in the enclosures of this Memorandum
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is highly desired.

DIVISION ACADEMICS AND CO-CURRICULAR COMPETITIONS FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES:

A. ACADEMIC CONTESTS

1) Spelling for the Hearing Impaired

Categories: A) Elementary Ages – 9 -13 B) Secondary – Ages 14 -18

- Each contestant should have a piece of paper and pen.
- The Quiz Master will announce the word to be spelled and the teacher-interpreter will give the corresponding hand sign for the given word.
- Contestant will be given twenty seconds to write the word. Time will start after the hand sign was given.
- Ten words will be given for the elementary and fifteen words for the secondary. Whoever gets the most number of correct answers is the winner.
- In case of tie, additional words will be given to break the tie.
- The first three will be declared as Winners.

2) Math for the Hearing Impaired

Categories: A) Elementary Ages – 9 -13 Secondary – Ages 14 -18

- Contestants will be given 5 problem solving questions for the Elementary and 10 problem solving questions for the secondary.
- Whoever gets the highest score is the winner. In case of tie, additional questions will be given.

B. CO-CURRICULAR COMPETITONS FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

1) On – the – Spot Poster Making Contest For the Hearing Impaired

Category A – Ages 9 – 13 **Category B – Ages 14 – 18**

Theme : ***"Karapatan ng Maykapansanan, Isakatuparan ... Now Na!"***

- Medium: Crayon/Craypas
Illustration Board – size: 15" x 20"
- The posters should be in a vertical position.
- The theme should be written as part of the poster.
- Duration: 3 hours
- Criteria:

Relevance to the theme	30%
Color Harmony	20%
Originality	25%
Creativity	25%

2) **Best Chefs**

- a) Group of 3 students to cook a special “putahe” of their choice.
- b) They will be given a maximum of 1 hour to cook after they presented the ingredients.
- c) They will be observed by the judges from the preparation to serving of food.

Criteria for Judging:

- 1. Taste
- 2. Economical
- 3. Presentation
- 4. Hygiene

3) **Search for Mr. and Ms. SPED 2016**

Entry: Down Syndrome/Intellectually Disabled

Special Awards: Best in Casual Wear Best in Sports Wear

Miss Talent Best in Gown

Presentation of Talent of each pair is limited to 5 minutes. 2 points per excess minute will be deducted from the rating obtained. Though the pair performs together, they will be graded separately. It is understood that the pair winners could be from different divisions.
