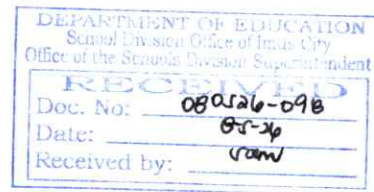

2026 WORLD FOOD DAY NATIONWIDE ON-THE-SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

The Department of Agriculture (DA), in partnership with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, will hold the 2026 World Food Day (WFD) Nationwide On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest.

This activity is one of the key highlights of the WFD celebration. This initiative engages Grade 5 and 6 learners from public and private elementary schools nationwide, with the aim of instilling in young learners the importance of WFD and its advocacy.

Specifically, the Contest aims to

1. raise awareness among grade school students on the fundamental right to food and the importance of access to nutritious food for a healthy and productive life;
2. inspire and empower young minds to become advocates of agricultural innovation, environmental sustainability, food security, and resilience through creative expression; and
3. encourage active learner participation in community-based food security and environmental advocacy initiatives.

The Regional-level Contest, including the National Capital Region, shall be conducted from August to September 2026 to support the national event. It will be facilitated by the DA-Agriculture and Fisheries Information Division and the DA regional offices through their respective Regional Agriculture and Fisheries Information Sections. The National-level Contest shall be held in Metro Manila on October 15, 2026.

Participation of learners shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2026, titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education and Activities and DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
