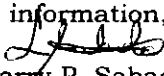

<i>Alkansyang Bahay</i> or Coin Bank Painting	Decorate a coin bank according to a preferred design.	Creativity, saving awareness, goalsetting
Pen Holder Painting	Decorate a functional desk or school item.	Creativity, functionality, responsibility
Ceramic Figurine Painting	Paint and personalize a ceramic figurine.	Attention to detail, creativity, patience
Clay Pot Painting	Decorate a clay pot using preferred colors and designs.	Creativity, appreciation of art and functional objects

Elementary, junior, and senior high school learners, together with other appropriate learner groups, are invited to participate in the event, subject to each activity's suitability for the intended age group.
