**DIVISION INTENSIVE TRAINING OF CAMPUS JOURNALISTS IN
PREPARATION FOR RRSPC 2026 AND AWARDING OF SCHOOL
PAPER ENTRIES**

1. The Schools Division Office of Imus City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct the Division Intensive Training of Campus Journalists in Preparation for RRSPC 2026 and Awarding of School Paper Entries on January 26 – February 18, 2026 (18 days) at Imus Pilot Elementary School, Imus National High School, Benedictine Institute of Learning and Del Pilar Academy, Imus City, Cavite.
2. The objectives of this training are to:
 - a. be equipped with practical writing and techniques relevant to campus journalism.
 - b. acquire advanced technical skills in preparation for the competition.
 - c. be prepared for the journ camp.
3. The best three (3) winners in the individual contest and the selected members of the team for group contests in the DSPC will attend this cliniquing. It is reiterated that attendance of learner contestants will be strictly monitored by the PMT. Three absences during the training will be subject for replacement. Teacher-coaches may attend the workshop upon their availability.

4. School Heads are requested to ensure the arrangement of schedule of the affected teachers and students in compliance with the Department's Time on Task policy. All concerned school paper advisers must monitor their contestants regarding their tasks in school and coordinate with the subject teachers. All subject teachers concerned are requested to give ample time to student learners under the intensive cliniquing period and participation to RRSPC 2026, in complying their school tasks.
5. All subject teachers must give consideration of all contestants who undergo their intensive cliniquing and during the conduct of the contests especially in giving grades, if not possible to increase their grades, it should be retained.
6. Expenses for food of the Program Management Team, training materials and speakers' honoraria shall be charged against Special Education Fund (SEF). However, travelling expenses and food of learner-participants and teacher-coaches shall be charged to the school MOOE or other local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
