

The Department of Education (DepEd) remains steadfast in its commitment to modernize educational management and ensure that every resource deployment decision is data-driven and precise. In line with this, **the Department announces the official rollout of the Strategic Resource Inventory for Deployment Efficiency (STRIDE) Dashboard.**

STRIDE serves as the central hub for viewing and analyzing comprehensive human resource and organizational development and infrastructure data across the Department. It addresses the longstanding challenge of fragmented information by consolidating critical datasets into a single, unified system. This system also transforms raw records into actionable data dashboards that drive strategic decisions.

The rollout of the STRIDE Dashboard aims to empower Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) with data-driven insights to strengthen our education systems. By shifting from scattered reports to a holistic analytics platform, stakeholders can now access vital statistics and perform deep-dive assessments. This capability is crucial for optimizing resource allocation, particularly in the critical areas of teacher deployment and infrastructure management.

To ensure the effective utilization of this platform, Regional Directors and Schools Division Superintendents are enjoined to adopt STRIDE in their local planning and decision-making processes. The dashboard provides the following specific benefits for field offices:

- **Evidence-Based Decision Making:** Facilitates the identification of resource gaps and surpluses to ensure equitable distribution of human resources and infrastructure.
- **Improved Efficiency:** Reduces the time spent on manual data consolidation, promoting greater focus on crafting strategic interventions.
- **Targeted Interventions:** Enables precise identification of schools with critical needs through geographic and hierarchical data visualization.

The STRIDE Dashboard features a suite of tools designed to support comprehensive analysis:

1. **Education Resource Dashboard:** Provides interactive bar graphs and charts for analyzing critical resources like teacher shortage, classroom and school building inventory, and enrolment figures.
2. **Drill-Down Capability:** Allows users to explore data hierarchically—from Region to Division, Municipality, District, and finally to the individual School level—by clicking on specific graphs.
3. **Multivariable Analysis:** Enables analysis of compounding variables of different datasets (e.g., "Classroom Shortage" vs. "Enrolment") for more in-depth analysis of resource needs
4. **Interactive School Locator:** Features a map interface that pins schools based on search criteria for easy geographic visualization.
5. **Resource Mapping:** Offers geographic analysis that visualizes resource distribution (e.g., teaching deployment, congestion, facilities) across a map to aid in equitable and effective resource distribution
6. **Reactive Data Tables:** displays tables that update instantly based on selected filters for real-time data viewing.
7. **Data Deployment & Export:** Serves as a centralized repository for viewing comprehensive tabular data, with options to export tables to CSV or Excel
8. **Quick Search:** Includes a fast search bar for finding specific schools by name without navigating complex menus.
9. **Automated Report Generation:** Converts dashboard insights and graphs into downloadable reports for offline analysis and seamless information sharing.
