PROACTIVE MEASURES TO ENSURE AND SUSTAIN CHILD PROTECTION OF LEARNERS IN SCHOOLS

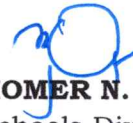
1. In the light of the prevalence of bullying and child abuse in the schools, this Office enjoins all public and private elementary and secondary schools to be on the red alert and intensify its **proactive measures to ensure and sustain child protection of learners in schools**.
2. This Office directs all schools to ensure adherence to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (DepEd Child Protection Policy), DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013 (Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10627, otherwise known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013), DepEd Order No. 7, s. 2006 (Reiterating the Prohibition of the Practice of Hazing and the Operation of Fraternities and Sororities in Elementary and Secondary Schools), and DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2015 (DepEd Guidelines and Procedures on the Management of Children-at-Risk (CAR) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL)).
3. The school heads are advised to report accordingly on or before March 6, 2026 any existing gangs, fraternities, sororities or other unlawful clubs or organizations involving learners inside the schools to the Division Office through the link <https://tinyurl.com/sdoicgangfraternitysorority>.
4. As part of the said proactive measures, this Office will soon be providing the schools a web-based and mobile application software called **Student Assistance and Feedback Environment (S.A.F.E.)-Imus** to facilitate reporting of violations of learner rights and initiate necessary and timely intervention.
5. This Office will also conduct surprise visits to all the schools to ensure the Child Protection Functionality.
