**ADMINISTRATION AND CONDUCT OF MONITORING OF THE
SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LITERACY AND NUMERACY
ASSESSMENTS FOR GRADE 11 LEARNERS
IN SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026 CUM TRAVEL ORDER**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 16, s. 2026 (Administration of the Senior High School Literacy and Numeracy Assessments for Grade 11 Learners in School Year 2025-2026), the Schools Division Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), hereby announces the administration of the Senior High School (SHS) Literacy and Numeracy Assessments for Grade 11 Learners in School Year (S.Y.) 2025-2026.
2. The **SHS Literacy and Numeracy Assessments (SHS LNA)** shall be administered to **Grade 11 students** in all stand-alone SHSs, private and public secondary schools offering SHS, and state/local universities and colleges (SUCs/LUCs) offering SHS nationwide on **Quarter 4 of S.Y. 2025-2026**. These assessments shall be used to determine the literacy and numeracy levels of Grade 11 students, guiding the development of remediation activities.
3. The **SHS Literacy Assessment** is designed to evaluate SHS learners' reading comprehension skills in both English and Filipino. It will determine each learner's reading profile—whether independent, instructional, or frustration level—and assess their performance across the domains of literal comprehension, inferential comprehension, and knowledge construction.
4. The **SHS Numeracy Assessment** is designed to evaluate SHS learners' numeracy skills and establish their proficiency levels, ranging from not proficient to highly proficient. It will also measure their performance across key mathematical domains: Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry, and Data and Probability.
5. The SHS LNA shall be administered on **March 16-18, 2026**. The checking and

recording of test results, as well as the submission of school reports, shall be completed on or before **March 25, 2026**.
