(OBSERVANCE OF FLEXIBLE WORKING HOURS FOR MUSLIM TEACHING AND
NONTEACHING PERSONNEL DURING THE HOLY MONTH OF RAMADAN)

1. Attached is **DepEd Memorandum No. 017, s. 2026** (Observance of Flexible Working Hours for Muslim Teaching and Nonteaching Personnel during the Holy Month of Ramadan) issued by the Department of Education Central Office dated March 6, 2026, for the information and guidance of all concerned.
2. The memorandum acknowledges the **Holy Month of Ramadan (February 19 to March 20, 2026)**, reaffirming the Department's commitment to supporting Muslim personnel in their religious observances while ensuring the uninterrupted delivery of basic education services.
3. Pursuant to Civil Service Commission and DepEd guidelines, Muslim personnel observing Ramadan may adopt a 7:00-9:00 A.M. start and 3:00-5:00 end time, totaling eight (8) hours of work without a lunch break.
4. Schools are encouraged to implement **Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs)** particularly during the final ten (10) days of Ramadan to support Muslim learners and staff in their intensified religious observances.
5. School heads are directed to ensure proper implementation of the provisions of the said memorandum while maintaining continuity of school operations and delivery of educational services.

**OBSERVANCE OF FLEXIBLE WORKING HOURS FOR MUSLIM TEACHING
AND NONTEACHING PERSONNEL DURING THE HOLY MONTH OF RAMADAN**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) recognizes and upholds the right of all teachers, learners, and nonteaching personnel to freely exercise their religion and observe their faith without discrimination or favoritism, in accordance with Section 5, Article III (Bill of Rights) of the 1987 Philippine Constitution.

2. The **Holy Month of Ramadan**, beginning on **February 19, 2026**, and concluding on **March 20, 2026**¹, with dates subject to the sighting of the moon, is recognized by the Department. DepEd respects the rights of all Muslim personnel to observe fasting during this period while ensuring the uninterrupted delivery of basic education services. Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs) are encouraged for Muslim personnel and learners who may face unique circumstances, such as fasting during the day and performing prayers at night and at dawn, particularly during the last ten days of *Ramadan*.

3. In accordance with the government's efforts to recognize and enforce Philippine Muslim holidays, the following policies and resolutions were issued to regulate office hours for Muslim teaching, nonteaching, and related teaching personnel in the Department during the Holy Month of *Ramadan*, as well as the implementation of ADMs.

- a. Paragraph No. 2 of Civil Service Commission (CSC) Resolution No. 81-1277, dated November 13, 1981, and Item No. 3 of Presidential Decree No. 322, s. 1973, modify the official hours of work to allow Muslim personnel observing the fast during the month of *Ramadan* to render work hours from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. without a noon break;
- b. DepEd Memorandum No. 291, s. 2008, titled "Guidelines for the Implementation of CSC Resolution No. 080096 on Working Hours for Public School Teachers" requires six hours of actual classroom teaching and two hours of work within or outside school premises for teaching personnel; and

- c. ADMs, as defined in Annex 3 (Flexible Learning Options: ADMs and Alternative Learning System) of DO 021, s. 2019 (Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program), cater to learners who are officially enrolled in the formal system but face unique circumstances that hinder them from regularly attending classes in schools.

4. In relation to this, all DepEd Muslim personnel nationwide, whether permanent, job order, contractual, temporary, or under a contract of service, and who are observing the fast while working during the Holy Month of *Ramadan*, are permitted to work under flexible working hours that begin from **7:00 AM** to **9:00 AM** and end from **3:00 PM** to **5:00 PM**, without a noon break to render a total of eight (8) hours per day.

5. All DepEd Muslim personnel and learners who are fasting during the day and praying at night and at dawn in quest of *Laylatul Qadr* (Night of Decree) are encouraged to observe ADMs only during the **last ten days of Ramadan**.


6. An orientation for Muslim parents and learners shall be conducted by the schools on the use of ADMs before the last ten days of *Ramadan*.
