**ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) PRACTICE,
ACCREDITATION & EQUIVALENCY (A&E) TEST (MOCK-TEST)**

1. Pursuant to **Republic Act No. 9155**, which includes Alternative Learning System (ALS) as part of basic education, and **RA 10533**, which recognizes ALS as a parallel learning system providing pathways for out-of-school youth and adults, this Office will hold an **Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Mock Test** for Imus City ALS learners on March 21, 2026. The test, which uses consolidated module questions to prepare learners for the upcoming ALS A&E Test, will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 nn. at the Imus Pilot Elementary School, PAGCOR Building.
2. The administration of the A&E Mock Test aims to:
 - a. help ALS learners familiarize themselves with the actual testing process, format, and types of questions, thereby reducing test anxiety and improving their confidence;
 - b. promote test readiness and enhance learners' time-management skills during examinations;
 - c. identify learners' strengths and areas for improvement;
 - d. provide facilitators with data to refine instructional strategies and deliver targeted remediation; and
 - e. increase the likelihood of higher passing rates in the actual A&E Test.
3. The ALS A&E Mock Test shall be administered by ALS teachers with the assistance of EPS II for ALS and under the monitoring of the Division ALS Focal Person. The administration of the test shall be guided by the total allotted test time. ALS teachers shall accomplish the learners' scoring sheet and item analysis which must be certified by the assigned Division EPS II for ALS.
