**INTENSIVE LIVE-IN TRAINING OF SELECT ATHLETES OF
THE PALARONG PAMBANSA 2026 CUM TRAVEL ORDER**

1. To prepare for the *Palarong Pambansa 2026*, the Division will hold a 15-day intensive live-in training camp for selected Imus City athletes from April 13-27, 2026.
2. Since the inclusive dates are part of the uninterrupted vacation for teachers, all participating DepEd coaches, assistant coaches, chaperons and trainers must submit a waiver confirming their voluntarily service for the live-in training.
3. General Pantaleon Garcia Senior High School will serve as the billeting center for the selected athletes.
4. The food provision for the delegation shall be released through the **payroll system (allowance)** in the amount of **Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P750.00) per day** for fifteen (15) days, or a total of **eleven thousand two hundred fifty pesos (P11,250.00) per person**, with the following indicative breakdown:


