The City Ordinance (Section 5.d) also provides that the support team shall receive cash incentives equivalent to the value of the incentive of the highest medal garnered by the athlete/academic students or the team he/she handles. In case of Team Category, the support team shall receive same cash incentives provided for the individual category. Support Team includes coaches, trainers, assistant trainers and persons alike (Section 3).
