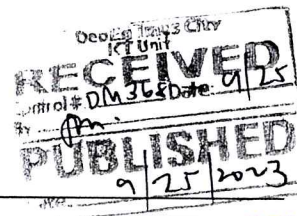

**SUPERTEEN-VITAMILK KALUSUGAN PARA SA
KINABUKASAN SCHOOL CARAVAN 2023**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**
Batangas, Cavite, Cabuyao, Lucena, Rizal and Antipolo City

1. In reference to the letter of Ms. Sarah C. Coe, President, Redscope Communication Incorporated, dated September 5, 2023¹, this Office, through the Education Support Services Division informs the concerned division offices on the relaunch of Superteen Campaign in selected schools in CALABARZON.
2. One of the objectives is championing proper nutrition among elementary and secondary school learners, this year's super teen campaign.
3. The activity is subject to the condition under the Department of Health Milk Code Monitoring kit, s. 2012, and Executive Order no. 51 s. 1986, particularly its Sections to read as follows:

Department of Health Milk Code Monitoring kit, s. 2012:

"Sec. 2. Purpose – These Revised Rules and Regulations are hereby promulgated to ensure the provision of safe and adequate nutrition for infants and young children by the promotion, protection, and support of breastfeeding and by ensuring the proper use of breastmilk substitutes, breastmilk supplements, and related products when these are medically indicated and only when necessary, on the basis of adequate information and through appropriate marketing and distribution.

Sec. 11. Prohibition – No advertising, promotions, sponsorships, or marketing materials and activities for breastmilk substitutes intended for infants and young children up to twenty-four (24) months, shall be allowed, because they tend to convey or give subliminal messages or impressions that undermine breastmilk and breastfeeding or otherwise exaggerate breastmilk substitute and/or replacements, as well as related products covered within the scope of this Code.

Section 16. All health and nutrition claims for products within the scope of the Code are absolutely prohibited.

Executive Order no. 51 s. 1986:

Section 6 - (a) *No advertising, promotion or other marketing materials, whether written, audio, or visual, for products, within the scope of this Code shall be printed, published, distributed, exhibited and broadcast unless such materials are duly authorized and approved by an inter-agency committee created herein pursuant to the applicable standards provided for in this Code."*

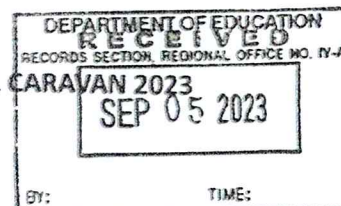

2. SCHOOL CARAVAN EVENT NO. 2: NUTRITION 101 FOR PARENTS AND TEACHERS (MINIMUM OF 100 PARTICIPANTS PER SCHOOL)

DURATION: 1 hour

VENUE: Auditorium/covered court/assembly hall/AVR or the like

SPEAKER: Registered Nutritionist-Dietician



- I. Assembly & registration in a designated venue within the school
- II. Welcome remarks by the School Representative
- III. Nutrition cornerstone of health
- IV. Closing & distribution of Vitamilk Soya Gift packs to all participants

Notes:

1. The School tour event will be implemented 1 day per school only. Max of 1 hour per event.
2. Redscope Personnel will be coordinating with the school to secure the best date/time to conduct the event.
3. The school will be requested for the following;
 - a. Provision of an appropriate venue for the event: for the learners' event & for the Health 101 for Teachers and Parents
 - b. Mobilization of target participants;
 - i. Students: Grade 7-10, (max of 1000)
 - ii. Parents & teachers for the Nutrition 101 talk (minimum of 100 per school)
