IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SECONDARY SCHOOL CAREER GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING ACT (REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11206)

Pursuant to Section 8 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11206 titled, "An Act Establishing a Career Guidance and Counseling Program for All Secondary Schools and Appropriating Funds Therefor," otherwise known as the "Secondary School Career Guidance and Counseling Act," the Department of Education (DepEd) hereby issues the following rules and regulations to implement the provisions of the Act.

RULE I. PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Section 1. Title. These rules and regulations shall be referred to as the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA No. 11206 otherwise known as the Secondary School Career Guidance and Counseling Act.

Section 2. Scope and Application. The provisions of this IRR shall apply to all public and private secondary schools and institutions including Community Learning Centers (CLCs).

Section 3. Interpretation. This IRR shall be interpreted in light of the Declaration of Policy found in Section 2 of the Act, which reads: "The State recognizes the role of the youth in nation building and in the acceleration of social progress. In this regard, the State shall ensure their total development by promoting relevant education that shall generate human resources to be responsive to the needs of the government, industry, and the economy."

Section 4. Objectives. Consistent with the provisions of RA No. 11206, DepEd, in coordination with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), Department of Economy, Planning, and Development (DEPDev), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), Department of of Science and Technology (DOST), Philippine Regulations Commission (PRC), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), other relevant agencies, including local government units and industry stakeholders, shall institutionalize a career guidance and counseling program to ensure that secondary education graduates are equipped with essential knowledge, skills, attitudes, values, and experiences needed for higher education, employment, entrepreneurship, and middle-level skills development to meet the requirements of the government, industry, and the economy, through interventions provided throughout basic education.

Section 5. Definition of Terms. For purposes of this IRR, the following terms shall mean or be understood as:

a. **Act** refers to RA No. 11206, titled An Act Establishing a Career Guidance and Counseling Program for All Secondary Schools and Appropriating Funds Therefor, or the Secondary School Career Guidance and Counseling Act;
