CONDUCT OF IN-SERVICE TRAINING (INSET) 2025

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum DM-OU-LS-2025-095, titled "Guidelines on the Conduct of the School Year 2025–2026 In-Service Training (INSET) for Teachers" dated 29 September 2025, the Schools Division of Imus City (SDOIC) shall conduct the Division-wide School-based INSET from October 27 – 29, 2025 with the theme:


From Standards to Practice: Advancing Teacher Competencies Aligned with PPST Indicators.

- 2. Relative to DepEd Memorandum No. 089, s. 2025 entitled "Guidelines on the Multi-Year Performance Management and Evaluation System (PMES) for Teachers from School Years 2025–2026 to 2027–2028," all teaching personnel are to undergo this preparatory capacity-building intervention that strengthens their understanding and application of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST). Teachers who will be serving and participating in other division-initiated activities shall be excused from attending INSET in-person. They, however, should do the asynchronous viewing of the NEAP Masterclass videos and submit the required reflection guide to be credited with a training certificate.
- 3. At the end of the training, participants are expected to:
 - a. Demonstrate a deeper understanding of PPST Domains 1–5 and their corresponding indicators;
 - b. Design lesson plans that reflect alignment with PPST indicators;
 - c. Exhibit effective classroom practices through demonstration teaching;
 - d. Engage in collaborative reflection to improve instruction and learner outcomes; and
 - e. Prepare supporting evidence aligned with the PPST for PMES documentation.
- 4. The INSET shall be conducted in all public elementary and secondary schools in the Division of Imus City except from the pre-identified schools that applied for CPD Accreditation for their 2025 INSET Programs.

5. The INSET shall follow the topic schedule below.

- 6. All teaching personnel shall participate. School Heads, L&D Coordinators, Master Teachers, and Head Teachers shall serve as INSET managers, ensuring alignment of school-based implementation with Division guidelines.
- 7. The INSET will employ the 4As Learning Framework (Activity, Analysis, Abstraction, and Application) within a Job-Embedded Learning (JEL) structure, combining NEAP video-based learning, reflection, and classroom simulation.

Expected outputs include:

- a. PPST-Aligned Lesson Plan
- b. Reflection Guide (individual reflection and synthesis)
- c. Peer Observation and Feedback Notes from Demonstration Teaching

All outputs shall serve as documentation for PMES and school-based HRD records.

- 8. Training Materials shall be distributed to the L&D Coordinators through their Official Group Chat. An online meeting is also scheduled for October 23, 2025, at 3:00 pm. Link to the virtual meeting room will be shared to the same group chat.
- 9. Expenses relative to the conduct of the INSET (e.g., materials, meals, certificates, documentation, and other logistical needs) may be charged against School MOOE or other available funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 10. For transparency and accountability, the approved proposed budget for INSET 2025 is enclosed in this Memorandum to serve as reference for budget utilization and liquidation purposes at the school level.
- 11. All school heads are directed to ensure full participation of teaching personnel and the faithful implementation of the learning sessions. Technical assistance shall be provided by the HRD Section and the assigned L&D Coordinators.
- 12. Other details related to the conduct of INSET shall be provided through a separate memorandum.
