SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR RESEARCH REQUEST ENDORSEMENT

- 1. To ensure that research initiatives align with the Basic Education Research Agenda, Research Management Guidelines, and adheres to necessary ethical and quality standards prior to implementation of a research study, all proponents, including internal personnel and external institutions or independent researchers, seeking to conduct studies within the DepEd system must submit a complete set of documentation for endorsement and approval.
- 2. Anent to this Proponents or requesting party are required to submit a complete set of documentation to facilitate the endorsement and approval process. These are as follows:
 - a. Formal endorsement/approval from the proponent's adviser or thesis adviser;
 - b. Request letter on the institution's official letterhead;
 - Complete research proposal (final/draft) with title, objectives, methodology, participants, timeline, and data-collection instruments attached;
 - d. Proof of ethics clearance from their institution's Research Ethics Committee (if available) or a signed Adviser's Certification or Statement of Ethical Compliance, confirming that the study will observe basic ethical principles, including voluntary participation, confidentiality, and the protection of participants' rights; and
 - e. Proof of student status (ID / enrollment certification) or employment (if staff).
