- 1. Pursuant to Memorandum No. 21, s. 2022 of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council titled "Conduct of the CY 2022 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)," OUA Memo 00-0222-017 titled "Reiteration of Participation to the 2022 1st Quarter NSED Activities," and Regional Memorandum No. 120, s. 2022 titled "Participation in the 2022 1st Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) Activities," this Office enjoins all SDO Offices and public schools to participate in the conduct of the 1st Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) on March 10, 2022.
- 2. With the limitation set by the IATF regarding the conduct of gathering, NSED exercises requiring physical interaction, particularly evacuation drills are suspended. However, all DepEd personnel and learners are enjoined to simultaneously practice "DROP, COVER and HOLD". Other activities such as orientation and discussion of the earthquake and health protocols are also encouraged.
