1. In line with the commitment to improving the educational experience and overall well-being of the learners, this Office, in collaboration with the City Government of Imus, announces the conduct of “Salamin, Salamin, Bigay ng Mayor Namin” for the remaining batches of S.Y. 2025-2026 Public Elementary and Secondary School Learners on **November 18-21, 2025, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, at the Government Center of Imus City, Imus Boulevard, Malagasang I-G, Imus City, Cavite**. The holding area for the learner-beneficiaries will be at the Function Hall (4th Floor) and the eye screening and consultation area will be at the HR Training Room (4th Floor).

2. The activity aims to conduct comprehensive vision screening for learners who require assistance in improving their vision and provide them with free eyeglasses to ensure they can see clearly.

3. Select learners from the remaining public elementary and secondary schools will participate in the said activity. Participating schools are reminded of the following:

- a. Parents’ Consent must be secured before the event;
- b. All of the participants are required to wear their proper uniform and ID;
- c. Learners and chaperones must wear face masks at the venue;
- d. Participants are encouraged to bring their filled water bottles;
- e. Only learners and chaperones are allowed in the service vehicles; and
- f. Chaperones should ensure that their learners are well-behaved and remind them to maintain the cleanliness and orderliness of the venue.

4. Enclosed is the number of learner-beneficiaries and chaperones for the remaining batches of S.Y. 2025-2026 public elementary and secondary school learners.
5. The City Government of Imus will provide transportation for the learner-beneficiaries and chaperones. The bus schedule and pick-up points will be disseminated through the official *Messenger* group chat.
